The load is projected out from the equipment's front so it is visible to the forklift operator. This type of forklift truck must only be utilized on prepared surface or on level, stable ground.

Forklift operators are required to obtain training which will enable them to better understand the right or proper method across the arms of the forklift. The trainee will learn to properly lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the lift truck mast, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. People training will be taught the RTITB standards required for safe forklift operation. Trainees will likewise know the types of attachments for the forklift arms.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

The counterbalance forklift known as the Walkie Pallet Truck is best suited for getting into spaces that are both cramped and small. This lift is highly maneuverable and capable of accessing practically any tight spot.

Walkie Stackers

This equipment is designed to access tighter areas and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. None of the Walkie line of lifts can be ridden. The driver has to walk behind them.

The Rider Pallet Truck is made so the operator could ride it. These riding lifts are perfect for dock unloading and loading.
