Forklift Training Guidelines

It is important that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to any question indicates a procedural flaw which may result in injury, damage to machinery or accident.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for pedestrians and operators?
- 6) Are alterations to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) The forklift tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift inspection and certification carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted correctly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the lift truck?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to use the equipment?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being operated?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the equipment and other lift truck incidences?
- 23) Prior to the machine being used, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed on a daily basis?
