Tower cranes are the tallest type, intended for constructing buildings. In order to access tight spaces, mini-cranes are used. Floating cranes are used on water for oil rig construction and salvaging operations.

Right training means less maintenance expenses and longer machine lifespan. The course instructs participants in inspection and operating procedures focused on all operational factors, including correct rigging and slinging. Participants can handle essential crane parts in order to familiarize themselves with mechanical components. Lifting practices will be shown together with recommended methods for review by your safety committee. Sessions would feature demonstration videos. The content of the course would cover machinery terminology; codes regarding overhead cranes, correct inspection ways; hoists and attachments; correct sling use; essential maintenance procedures and requirements.
