Theory Programs

The theory topics include: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; rigging knowledge; crane operation knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane rigging charts; crane pre-trip inspections & set-up, and crane maintenance and service.

Practical Programs

The crane training school comprises practical training involving hands-on learning. This component teaches trainees how to identify crane terminology and components. Individuals training will have the chance to practice skills considered necessary for crane signaling, rigging and operating.

Practical course topics: Identify crane functions and components; Learn crane terms; utilize remote control; identify wire ropes and rigging; pre-use inspection on crane; identify regulations and documents for rigging and wire rope; use radio and hand signals; carry out correct lowering and lifting of loads and carry out rigging methods.
